

C2H5 C02H Metasulphobenzoyl chloride, C7H4S03C12, is obtained by heating the dry acid with phosphorus pentachloride; the phosphorus oxychloride is then distilled off and the residue washed with water. It is a thick, oily liquid, which has a faint but unpleasant odour, and decomposes on distillation into sulphur dioxide and metachloroberizoyl chloride. The latter is also formed when the...
