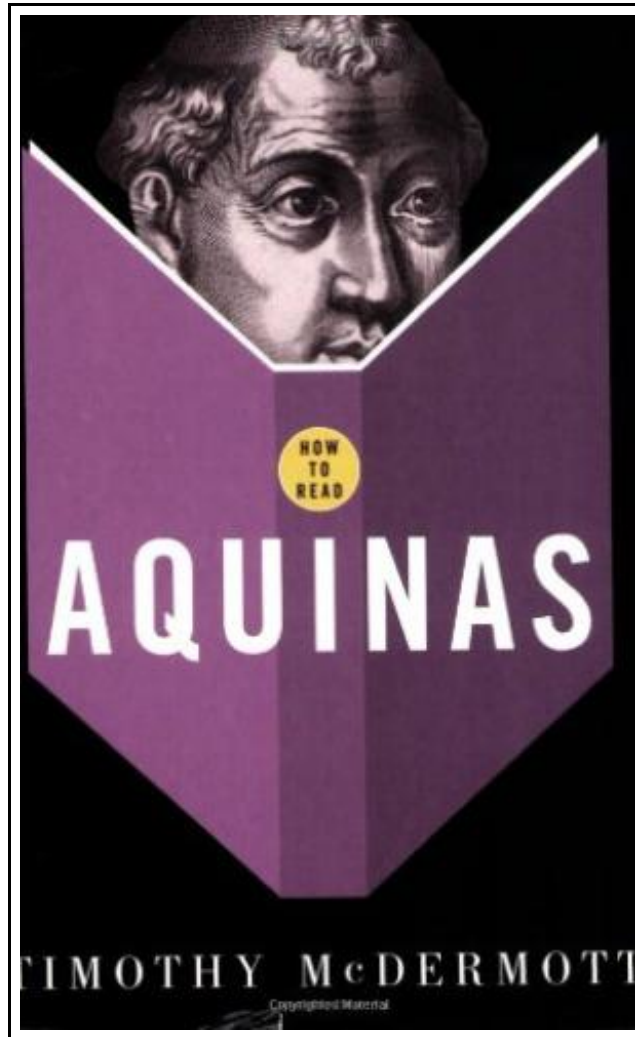

He considers the role of regularity and chance in the natural world, mind and matter, freedom and moral obligation, law and society, suffering and evil, hope and hopelessness, and what place can rationally be given to Jesus Christ, to religion and churches, to faith and love and a God. Extracts are taken from the records of Aquinas's classroom disputations ("Quaestiones Disputatae") and two brilliant conspectuses of his teaching: the *Summa Contra Gentes* attempting a reasoned dialogue with non-Christian (mainly Arabic) scholars, and the *Summa Theologiae* addressed to his Christian students. 116 pages. 19.2 x 12.8 x 1 cm.
